Rainer-Marc Frey is the founder and Chairman of Horizon21.

Horizon21 is an independent investment manager with a focus on alternative investments. Horizon21 develops investment solutions to well-known international and national institutional clients. The company offers wealth management with a main focus on alternative investments to sophisticated private clients. Horizon21 was founded in 2004 and employs around 80 people in five locations.

Rainer-Marc Frey has a proven track record in investment banking and is a recognized expert in the financial services industry. He began his international career in 1987 and held various positions in the areas of equity derivatives, trading and syndication at Merrill Lynch Inc. and Salomon Brothers Inc.

In 1992 he founded his own company RMF Investment Group. Under his leadership, RMF evolved into one of the leading providers of alternative investment products in Europe.

In 2002 Man Group plc acquired RMF Investment Group to form Man Investments. The new organization became the world's largest alternative investment management firm with an asset base in excess of USD 40 billion at the end of 2004.

From 2002 until 2005, Rainer-Marc Frey held various Senior Executive roles at Man Investments and was instrumental to the successful integration of the two companies.

Rainer-Marc Frey serves on the Board of Directors of UBS AG, one of the world's leading banks. At UBS, he is a member of the Risk Committee. He is also a member of the Board of Directors of DKSH, a leader in market expansion services in Asia. At DKSH, he is a member of the Audit and Finance Committee.
