Thomas Ledergerber



Thomas Ledergerber joined Horizon21 in June 2005. He is the Head of Internal Audit & Compliance of Horizon21.

Thomas Ledergerber has an extensive knowledge in the areas of internal audit and corporate governance for financial institutions. He started his career in 1984 as an apprentice in an industrial company. He changed his career path by crossing over industry lines and joining the financial sector. His extensive experience at the Cantonal Bank of Zurich included work for the departments fund transfers, check processing, cash register, securities back office, and investment advisory services.

In 1994, he took on a new challenge in the audit and assurance department of PricewaterhouseCoopers in Zurich, Switzerland. As Manager, he was responsible for the statutory and regulatory audits of banks, securities dealers, and mutual funds. He also participated in special projects for such companies.

Upon joining RMF Investment Group in 2000, he became instrumental to implementing a company-wide quality management system in accordance with ISO 9001:2000 standards. Another key accomplishment was the honor of being granted a securities dealer licence by the Swiss Federal Banking Commission for RMF Capital Markets. A year later he was commissioned by RMF Investment Group to open an overseas branch in the Bahamas, which he led for nearly four years. His achievements were obtaining the first broker dealer licence for an alternative investment secondary market and the implementation of a comprehensive corporate governance-structure for the over 250 investment companies for which he acted as a Director.
