Christophe Rouvinez is the Chief Risk Officer of Horizon21. He joined the company in September 2007.

Christophe Rouvinez has extensive experience in private equity and risk management. He began his career in 1995 as a Quantitative Analyst at Credit Suisse in Zurich, Switzerland, where he was responsible for developing and implementing Value-at-Risk models.

In 1997, he became Vice President and Head of Emerging Market Risk Management at Credit Suisse First Boston in London, Great Britain, where he enhanced the models and the reporting of the market risks of that business unit.

The following year Christophe Rouvinez took over market risk consolidation as a Director at Credit Suisse, Zurich, Switzerland, being instrumental in the Value-at-Risk certification by the Swiss Federal Banking Commission (SFBC).

In 2000, he joined Capital Dynamics in Zug, Switzerland, as a Senior Partner. His responsibilities included risk management, quantitative modeling, and research on alternative assets. His groundbreaking work was essential in providing attractive financing from the capital markets with AAA rated bonds for private equity structured transactions.
